ASA:

- -Next year's passes available Apr1. CLSC could buy paper ones to sell instead of only digital. Online for now and awaiting ASA to see if they change it.
- -Registrations for the Sled Show open in June if we are interested (two days), table until year end meeting question to see if club would pay for cost of trip and hotel for attendees. Something that needs to be discussed and agreed to at another meeting.
- -Once the grooming season starts the club needs to give a grooming update to the ASA so they can update their trail maps weekly. (No GPS units for groomers anymore, this program has been shelved)
- -Lenny to update ASA every Wednesday on trail conditions
- -As of Nov 7 there were 23 members, not including the 4 that went to the Ironhorse Trail Society. Lenny will talk to the ASA as the Iron Horse Grooming Committee should not take our trail passes. We will discuss with them to find a better way in order to keep our club membership.
- -We need to submit volunteer and equipment hours, pictures of work before, during and after, grooming too. Chad and Lisa to update the volunteer sheet and send out again for this season. Anyone doing volunteer work should take pictures. Need to discuss where there pictures go. Website? Members in action?
- -I applied for the ASA grant (up to \$10,845 __.3330.00 for length of trail and 7515.00 for membership)

-ASA Jamboree: As of the ASA AGM, no club volunteered to host the ASA Jamboree. Have we done this in the past? Should we plan for it next year? It doesn't have to be a poker rally, it could be in conjunction with Sleds and Threads. General thought was to keep it small this year and build from this going forward

-Any other new business?

-Sean and Mara brought up during Sleds and Threads to pay Ashley in the future. Discussed briefly. Chad thought the discussion should be tabled to next meeting when Brian and Ian are not present due to the conflict of interest. Just to discuss what that compensation might look like

-Bridges in Dean's yard that weigh a lot. What to do with them? Very heavy? Dean said we will need to put piling in if we ever use them. Dean will store in his pasture for now. Can we remove the concrete from them and use planking. More discussion in the future.
