# DIRECTOR'S REPORTS

VP: Tylor continuing with updates on website. Website is a big hit have 20K views. Website Fees and FB plug in ability costs us so much per year. Dean made a motion to have Tylor spend up to 1000.00 per year for upgrades as required. Mara seconded it and all was in favor. This is a great addition to us and we need to keep it current and working.

Trail Coordinator: Rode from Crane Lake west to Tucker Lake. Trail will need to be mulched to clean it up. We can use the Power line ROW to make a loop back to our cabin. Dean mentioned we should try and ride it for signage requirements and potential crossing agreements in the next few weeks if possible.

Manhole covers on City trail need to be marked better. Chad will chat with the city and see if this is something we can get done this summer.

Groomer Director: Groomer Update

- (Coolant Leak) Leak down test was completed and found leaking hoses. Hoses were tightened up. Leak seems to be fixed but might need to run machine longer to check it out.
- Engine cover Hinges fixed and re-welded. (Donation from ProSteel)
- Removable Sign Frames built and installed ready for decals. (Donation from ProSteel)
- Cracks in Tiller were ground out and welded up (Donation from ProSteel)
- Serrated edge taken off Tiller, had to grind the bolts off. Sean bought new bolt up, need to order a new one (Sean priced out new one 810) didn't order need to discuss at next meeting. I feel it should be replaced. Randy can't build one cheaper.
- New ignitions switch as per our last meeting not ordered yet. He also got an oil filter for it and got us some oil.
- Martin diagnosed Fuel gauge problem needs a new sending unit.
- Martin has sourced out all the hydraulic caps we will need to pull off the ski track setters.

- Randy got groomer hauled to Chad's shop and parked it inside.
- Sean and Chad verified a few things for service and air box housing, We ran it up more found an exhaust leak under cab that needs to be fixed

- Oil change and service, includes greasing.
- Source out and order new Air filter Housing and air filter Sean gave Dwight measurements and Dwight will source out.
- Install new ignition switch when it comes in (Ordered)
- Install new serrated edge for tiller when it comes in (Ordered)
- Shorten Fuel Filler hose to take kink out of it
- Play with Hydraulic settings on cab lift, looks like there is something we can adjust.
- Run permanent Fuel solenoid wire and put in protective sheath.
- Repair exhaust leak under cab.
- Replace missing nut on turbo housing.
- Diagnose and repair fuel gauge, tried to get new sending unit but OEM parts unavailable, might have to come up with a plan B
- Remove or find a way to lock Ski setters. Diagnose what problem is possibly take off to fix and cap off Hydraulics if required.
- Bring K-3 down to look at Unit build decals for the sign frames (Cold Lake Snowmobile Club Logo)

- Look at getting our Sponsors on the machine Decals to fit on machine (DD) (Browns) (Fountain Tire) (ProSteel)
